Margaret Mead was a famous American *anthropologist. She was born on December 16, 1901, in Pennsylvania. Her parents and grandmother were teachers. They believed that it was very important for children to receive education. Margaret learned a lot of things from her parents and grandmother.

When she was a child, Margaret's family traveled in various countries. Margaret was always interested in people and places, so she decided to study anthropology in college to learn about different cultures. At that time, it was not very common for women to study in a university. It was even more unusual for women to study anthropology.

After Margaret graduated from college, she went to *Samoa to study about young women there. She wanted to learn about Samoans so that the world could learn about them, too. She lived in Samoa for nine months and learned the language. She tried to communicate with the Samoan people as much as possible, especially the teenage girls. She ate and danced with them, so that she could learn many details about their peaceful culture.

When Margaret returned to the United States, she wrote a book about the young Samoan women she studied. The book was called *Coming of Age in Samoa*, and it sold well. As a result, Margaret Mead became very famous. She played an important role in making anthropology a popular subject.

Margaret Mead studied many different cultures in her life. She continued to work, travel, write, and teach until she died in 1978. She was a remarkable woman of the world.
